


St. Paul's News Bulletin November 19, 2023

At present there is one volunteer each week. The volunteers work in rotation, which turns out to be about once a month. Set-up can be done Friday or Saturday as suits your schedule. During the Christmas and Easter seasons we have need for extra shifts, which are covered on a volunteer basis.
